



# Geography

## Intent

At Newcroft Primary Academy, Geography enables our children to become inspired and fascinated with the world around them.

Teachers create Knowledge Organisers to support the teaching of Geography, enabling the children to become more independent and confident learners whilst acquiring, developing and consolidating key knowledge of four areas (locational knowledge, place knowledge, Human and physical geography and Geographical skills and fieldwork).

Geography lessons are structured to cover the skills required in order to meet the aims of the national curriculum. Planning is based on the Whole School Plan and is progressive each year, focussing on developing and improving geographical vocabulary, map skills and geographical facts. Pupils develop contextual knowledge of significant places of the world, the United Kingdom and of their own locality.

## Impact

**Whole class teaching of Geography (covering the 4 geographical domains).**

Children are being taught key vocabulary, geographical skills and knowledge. This begins as developing knowledge about their locality. This then progresses to the United Kingdom and the wider world.

**Discrete teaching e.g. assemblies, sports and cross-curricular lessons.**

Children are learning to become global citizens and to compare and contrast their own country and lives to others.

**Knowledge Organisers**

Allows children to independently complete morning challenge work which also deepens and consolidates knowledge of key facts, vocabulary and geographical skills.
